### **KEEP LEARNING: Continuing Education Scholarship**

Thank you for the opportunity to serve as your Chair of Professional Training and Standards (PTS) Scholarship Committee. I look forward to working with my committee members-Debra Stack, Katie Hutton, and DeEtta Rivens (Ex-officio). This is my first year serving on PTS as well as my committee members and I'm sure I can speak for them in saying we will do our best to fulfill our duties. DeEtta has done a great job serving as chairperson over the past three years and I will not hesitate to ask for her assistance.

The purpose of the PTS Committee is to recommend for consideration the academic standards for continuing education, oversee the review and grant process of scholarship applications for continuing education, obtain approval of upcoming Chapter Retreats and individual CEU credits from PAUMCS National, provide retreat participant CEU certificates, and maintain chapter training and scholarship records.

As a PAUMCS member, continuing education is important to your individual growth, professional development, and spiritual enrichment. We encourage your participation in the various events and activities hosted by our chapter. Financial assistance is available for our Chapter Fall Retreat, GCFA PAUMCS On-line Certification and National PAUMCS Conference. If you are interested in any of these opportunities but are limited due to finances, you can apply for a scholarship to help with one-half the cost of registration. Application may be made only after approaching your employer (church/agency) for financial assistance. Approved scholarships will be granted for up to one-half the cost of registration fees. Attendance is required at all educational sessions. The application can be obtained by contacting the PTS Chair and must be returned a minimum of 30 days prior to the event. Applications must be accompanied by letters of reference from the senior pastor, Staff-Parish Relations Chair, and one other member of the church where the applicant is employed. Scholarships can be granted to the same person once every two years.

The National Conference will be held at Lake Junaluska April 21-23, 2022, and our chapter is hosting it. The theme of the conference is "Refresh, Renew, Restore". The registration fee is \$200 for a National Member and \$250 for a Non-member. (The National Membership fee is \$50 so put your \$50 toward joining and then pay the \$200 registration fee.) If you have never been to a National Conference (www.paumcs.org), this would be a good place to start because it is in "our neck of the woods" and the registration cost is less than in previous years. Your continuing education is a part of ministry important and vital to the life of the church/agency. Don't let the financial aspect keep you from enhancing your ministry. If you need financial assistance, be sure to consider a scholarship application.

I hope you are planning on attending the national PAUMCS annual conference at Lake Junaluska in April. Our Western North Carolina Chapter is hosting this event, and we need you to help the Executive Committee. I just returned from a meeting in Minneapolis with the national PAUMCS Executive Committee with last minute instructions. The registration brochure is attached to the newsletter with detailed information on our speakers, worship leaders, mission project,

etc.

We need help with hospitality and transportation. We need greeters to be at the Asheville airport to welcome our guests. Other ways you can provide assistance is by helping the worship committee with worship centers, memorial service preparation, etc. We also need persons to help distribute favors before each session.

A fun thing that will happen is that 2022 is the 40<sup>th</sup> birthday of PAUMCS, which began in April 1982 in Dallas, Texas. Everyone is encouraged to wear Ruby Red to the celebration/closing banquet on April 23. This can be in clothing, jewelry, shoes, etc. It will be fun to see all of us decked out in Ruby Red.
