

What is the **Medication Management Program**?

- High-Cost medications can be a burden to all members on the insurance plan if used inappropriately. However, when used as intended they may provide priceless improvements to health and overall quality of life
- The purpose of this program is not to interfere with access to the medication; but to help members attain optimal outcomes from the treatment
- Though the Program is employer sponsored, WNCC-UMC WILL NOT have access to any personal health information
- The Program will provide the member with personalized support and education from one of our uniquely trained pharmacist care managers
- The member will receive periodic calls from their assigned pharmacist care manager to discuss proper administration and storage, potential side effects, drug interactions, intended outcomes and answer any questions the member may have with regards to the medication
- Some members on high-cost medications will be more suited to one of the HealthMap Rx chronic condition care management programs for diabetes, cardiovascular disease, or depression
- Enrollment and participation in either the Medication Management Program or one of the HealthMap Rx Programs will satisfy the medication's insurance coverage requirement

Do **YOU** need to enroll?

- If you have filled a prescription in the past 6 months for one or more qualifying medications, you will receive a letter from PPCN with instructions for enrolling
- For new prescriptions, program participation will be required for prior authorization along with any other prior authorization or step therapy criteria as indicated on the PharmAvail 2024 Focused Formulary

- Individualized support from a **Pharmacist Care Manager** with advanced expertise in care management will meet with you virtually or telephonically an average of 4 times per year.
